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county offices, amended. Paragraph seven of section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as further amended by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the words "twenty-three hundred dollars" in the first and second lines of said paragraph and inserting in place thereof the words 'twenty-five hundred dollars,' and by striking out the words "seven hundred and eighty dollars" in the second and third lines of said paragraph and inserting in place thereof the words 'one thousand and forty dollars,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Kennebec county: Increases in offices of register of deeds and register of probate. For clerks in the office of register of deeds, twenty-five hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate, one thousand and forty dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, fifteen hundred dollars.'

Chapter 55.

An Act to Amend Section Three of Chapter Two Hundred and Sixty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen as Amended by Chapter One Hundred of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Applications for Soldiers' Bonus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1919, c. 264; 1921, c. 100; relating to application for soldiers' bonus, amended. Section three of chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by chapter one hundred of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is hereby further amended by striking out the word "twenty-two" in the third line thereof and inserting in place thereof the word 'twenty-four,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Time extended to December 31, 1923. Applications for such bonus shall be filed with the adjutant general, on forms provided by him, before the first day of January, nineteen hundred twenty-four. Such application shall state facts sufficient to establish the status of such applicant as soldier as defined herein, and shall be duly verified.'
