SALARY, REGISTERS OF PROBATE.

CHAP. 56

Chapter 56.

An Act to Amend Section Thirty-nine of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, as Amended, Relating to Salaries of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 39; 1917, c. 167; 1919, c. 214; 1921, c. 219; relating to salaries of registers of probate, amended. Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and sixty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, chapter two hundred and fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen by striking out the words "one thousand" in the eighteenth line thereof and inserting in place thereof the words 'twelve hundred,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 39. Increase in Waldo County; \$1200. Registers of probate in the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly payments paid on the last of each month, as follows:

Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars, Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars, Cumberland, two thousand dollars, Franklin, nine hundred dollars, Hancock, one thousand dollars, Kennebec, eighteen hundred dollars, Knox, twelve hundred fifty dollars, Lincoln, nine hundred dollars, Oxford, fifteen hundred dollars, Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars, Piscataquis, twelve hundred dollars, Sagadahoc, one thousand dollars, Somerset, fifteen hundred dollars, Waldo, twelve hundred dollars, Washington, one thousand dollars,

York, fifteen hundred dollars.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of registers of probate.'
