Chapter 97.

Resolve, in Favor of the Maine School for Feeble Minded for Additions and Improvements.

School for Feeble Minded, new construction and improvements. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Maine School for Feeble Minded for new construction and improvements for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-four to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the sum of one hundred and forty thousand dollars to be spent by the trustees of the institution, under the direction of the governor and council.

Provided, further, that the sum herein appropriated shall be expended as follows:

Build one dormitory, provide necessary equipment, heat, light, water and sewerage connections; provided that any balance of the sum above appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-four which may remain unexpended at the end of the period June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, shall be available for expenditure, during the period July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-five to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six.
