tion shall not apply between the seventeenth day of December and the twenty-fourth day of December, both inclusive, and shall not apply during the eight days prior to Easter Sunday to persons employed in millinery shops and stores. In case of emergency, in which there is danger to property, life, public safety or public health and in cases of extraordinary public requirement the provisions of this act shall not apply to employers engaged in public service.

The governor is hereby requested to issue his proclamation, referring the within act to the people, at a special election to be held not less than four or more than six months after such proclamation.

Chapter 108.

Resolve, in Favor of Anne M. Clancy.
