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## CHAP. 117.

### Chapter 117.

Resolve, in Favor of Somerset Academy.

**Somerset academy, in aid of. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars for the fiscal period beginning July first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, and seven hundred fifty dollars for the fiscal period beginning July first, nineteen hundred twenty-four, to be paid to Somerset academy, so-called, in the town of Athens, to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said institution.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for the Establishment of a Test Laboratory at Bangor in the County of Penobscot.

Test laboratory at Bangor, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be appropriated the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred twenty-four, and one thousand five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred twenty-five, to be expended by the state department of health under the direction of the governor and council for the purpose of establishing, equipping and maintaining a test laboratory for Penobscot county, same to be located at Bangor.
