Chapter 129.

Resolve, for Charitable and Benevolent Institutions, for the Care, Support and Medical or Surgical Treatment of Certain Persons.

Charitable and benevolent institutions. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-three to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of one hundred eighty-seven thousand four hundred fifty dollars, and for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-four to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the sum of one hun-

dred eighty-seven thousand, four hundred fifty dollars, for the necessary care and medical or surgical treatment, at the rates specified and in, or by, the institutions and organizations named, of certain classes of persons whose own resources, or the resources of whose responsible relatives as defined by section eighteen of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes, are insufficient to pay for the same, and for other purposes, namely:

For the care and support of children under sixteen years of age including those supported away from their parents under the provisions of sections fifty-one to fifty-five inclusive, chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof, at not to exceed three dollars and fifty cents per week, including direct payments from sources other than the state:

Chapter 130.

Resolve, in Favor of the State Armory at Lewiston.

State armory at Lewiston, furnishing. Resolved: That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars be, and is hereby, appropriated, to be expended under the direction of the armory commission, for providing seats and furnishings for the state armory at Lewiston.

Chapter 131.

Resolve, in Favor of the State Park Commission.

State park commission, maintenance and improvement. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state park commission for maintenance and improvement of the state park in Augusta, the sum of two thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and one thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five; the expenditure thereof to be under the direction of the governor and council.
