## Chapter 39.

An Act Relating to Salaries and Expenses of County Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 117, sec. 42; P. L., 1917, c. 173; 1919, cc. 214 and 241; 1921, c. 219; 1923, c. 103; relating to compensation of county commissioners, amended. Section forty-two of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and seventy-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as amended by chapters two hundred and fourteen and two hundred and forty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as amended by chapter one hundred and three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "three hundred dollars" in the twelfth line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'three hundred and fifty dollars,' so that the twelfth line of said section shall read as follows:

**Lincoln county, increased.** 'Lincoln, three hundred and fifty dollars.'

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## Chapter 40.

An Act Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Registry of Deeds for Lincoln County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; P. L., 1919, c. 261, sec. 2; relating to clerk hire in county offices, amended. Paragraph nine of section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by paragraph three of section two of chapter two hundred and sixty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen is hereby further amended by striking out the word "four" in the second line of said paragraph and inserting in place thereof the word 'six,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

**Clerk hire in office of register of deeds, increased.** 'Lincoln County; for clerks in the office of register of deeds six hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate one hundred sixty dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, two hundred dollars.'
