amended. Section fifteen of chapter fifteen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby amended by striking out in the third line thereof the word "three," and inserting in place thereof the word 'four,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salary of recorder increased. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of six hundred dollars per annum to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of four hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly.'

Chapter 54.

An Act to Increase the Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, sec. 15, as amended; relating to Millinocket municipal court, amended. Section fifteen of chapter three hundred and ninety-three of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine, as amended by chapter two hundred and twenty of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, and as further amended by chapter nineteen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, is hereby further amended by striking out the word "eight" in the second line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word 'twelve'; also by striking out the word "four" in the third line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word 'six,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder increased. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of twelve hundred dollars per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of six hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly.'

Chapter 55.

An Act Providing for and Fixing the Salaries of the Probation Officer and Assistant Probation Officer for the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
