Chapter 1.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for the Expenses of the Electoral College for the State of Maine for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five.

Expenses of electoral college. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of three hundred and fifty-four dollars to defray the expenses of the electoral college for the State of Maine which convened at Augusta on the tenth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-five.

Approved February 5, 1925.

Chapter 2.

Resolve, in Favor of George H. Chick.

George H. Chick, services at organization of 82d legislature. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty-five dollars for services and eleven dollars for mileage to be paid to George H. Chick, of Monmouth, page of the eighty-first legislature, for services and attendance at the organization of the eighty-second legislature.
