Chapter 13.

Resolve, in Favor of Newell Gabriel, Representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Newell Gabriel, representative Penobscot Indians 82d legislature. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Newell Gabriel, representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians at the eighty-second session of the legislature, one hundred sixty-five dollars for attendance and eighteen dollars for mileage.

Approved March 14, 1925.

Chapter 14.

Resolve, in Favor of Frank Socoby, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Indians, Eighty-second Legislature.

Frank Socoby, representative Passamaquoddy Indians 82d legislature. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred and sixty-five dollars to be paid Frank Socoby, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Indians, for attendance at the eighty-second legislature, and the sum of forty-five dollars for mileage.

Chapter 15.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians for the Years July First, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five, to June Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-seven.

Passamaquoddy Indians, care and maintenance of. Resolved: That there be paid from the state treasury, to be expended under the direction of the governor and council, to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the benefit of said tribe for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-five to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as follows:
