CHAP. 54

July 1, 1925—June 30, 1926

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty thousand dollars,

\$50,000.00

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, twenty-eight thousand dollars.

28,000.00

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand three hundred dollars.

3,300.00

And be it further resolved that there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Maine State Prison for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, inclusive, the further sum of eighty-one thousand three hundred dollars for the purposes hereinbefore specified, divided as follows, namely:

July 1, 1926—June 30, 1927

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty thousand dollars,

\$50,000.00

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, twenty-eight thousand dollars,

28,000.00

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand three hundred dollars.

Chapter 54.

Resolve, Granting Authority to the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station for the Purchase of Land.

Highmoor farm, authority to purchase additional land. Resolved: That authority be granted to the trustees of the university of Maine and the director of the Maine agricultural experiment station to purchase additional land for Highmoor farm, so-called, in the town of Monmouth. The amount to be paid for the same not to exceed three thousand dollars, said sum to be taken from any funds granted to the Maine agricultural experiment station by the eighty-second legislature.
