Interest on trust funds.

And be it further resolved: that there be and hereby is appropriated for the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, inclusive, the further sum of sixty-six thousand five hundred and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

July 1, 1926, to June 30, 1927

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees, \$19,

Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materals for their fabrication and repair,

31,000.00

Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,

Provided, that the governor and council, may, by order, upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.
