#### Chapter 53.

An Act Relating to Digging Out of Fox Dens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, sec. 47; P. L., 1917, c. 219; 1919, c. 196; relating to digging out fox dens, amended. Section forty-seven of chapter thirty-three of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as amended by chapter one hundred ninety-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, is hereby further amended by striking out in the second line thereof the words "during closed season on foxes," and by striking out in the sixth line thereof the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'twenty-five,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 47. Perpetual closed time on digging out fox dens; penalty increased. No person shall at any time dig out, molest, or destroy, in any way, any fox den or fox dens, or remove or cause to be removed therefrom any fox or foxes, except those enclosed in private fox ranches. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay a fine of twenty-five dollars and costs for each offense.'

#### Chapter 54.

An Act Relating to the Time and Place of Holding the County Commissioners
Court in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 83, sec. 5; relating to sessions of county commissioners courts, amended; terms in York county changed. Section five of chapter eighty-three of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby amended by striking out the twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth, thirtieth and thirty-first lines of said section and inserting in place thereof the words, 'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of April and October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month, January and February at Saco, all other months at Alfred,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows in the twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth, thirtieth and thirty-first lines: 'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of April and October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month, January and February at Saco, all other months at Alfred.'
