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## Chapter 81.

An Act Relating to Salaries of Registers of Probate.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 117, sec. 39, as amended; relating to salaries of registers of probate, amended. Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and sixty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, chapter two hundred and fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen and chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and as amended by chapter fifty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "nine hundred dollars" in the twelfth line thereof and inserting in place thereof the words 'twelve hundred dollars,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 39. Lincoln county increased to \$1200. Registers of probate in the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly payments, paid on the last of each month, as follows:

Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars,  
Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars,  
Cumberland, two thousand dollars,  
Franklin, nine hundred dollars,  
Hancock, one thousand dollars,  
Kennebec, eighteen hundred dollars,  
Knox, twelve hundred fifty dollars,  
Lincoln, twelve hundred dollars,  
Oxford, fifteen hundred dollars,  
Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars,  
Piscataquis, twelve hundred dollars,  
Sagadahoc, one thousand dollars,  
Somerset, fifteen hundred dollars,  
Waldo, twelve hundred dollars,  
Washington, one thousand dollars,  
York, fifteen hundred dollars.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of registers of probate.'
