Chapter 89.

An Act to Amend Section Fifty-five of Chapter Two of the Revised Statutes,
Relating to the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 2, sec. 55; relating to preparing tables of changes in statutes by secretary of state, amended. Section fifty-five of chapter two of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "statutes" in the fourth line thereof the words, 'and in addition thereto shall make a complete index of all public laws passed subsequent to the last revision of the statutes,' and by inserting in the fourth line of said section after the word "tables," the words, 'and index,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 55. Complete index of all public laws to be prepared. After final adjournment of each regular session of the legislature, he shall cause tables to be prepared showing what general statutes have been affected by subsequent legislation in such manner as to furnish ready reference to all changes in such statutes, and in addition thereto shall make a complete index of all public laws passed subsequent to the last revision of the statutes. The tables and index so prepared shall be printed in the official edition of the laws hereafter published by the state. The compensation for the services herein provided for shall be fixed by the governor and council.'

Chapter 90.

An Act Relating to Certain State Parks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1925, c. 183, sec. 1; relating to state parks, amended. Section one of chapter one hundred eighty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby amended by adding after the word "Phippsburg" in the fifth line thereof the following: 'and the lot of land conveyed to the state of Maine by the First Maine Heavy Artillery Association, situated in Petersburg, in the state of Virginia,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Lot of land at Petersburg, Va., conveyed to state by First Maine Heavy Artillery Ass'n, made a state park. All that portion of the state lands comprising Fort Machias at Machiasport; Fort Knox at Prospect; Fort Edgecomb at Edgecomb; Fort St. George's at St. George; Fort McClary at Kittery; Fort Baldwin, Fort Popham and the North and
