Chapter 223.

An Act Relating to the Salary of the County Attorney for Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 37; as amended; relating to salaries of county attorneys, further amended. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "five hundred" after the word "Franklin" in the seventh line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'seven hundred and fifty,' so that said section, so far as it relates to the salary of the county attorney for Franklin county, shall read as follows:

Franklin county increased. 'Franklin, seven hundred and fifty dollars.'

Chapter 224.

An Act Relating to the Salary of the County Attorney for the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 37; as amended; relating to salaries of county attorneys, further amended. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "seven hundred fifty" after the word "Hancock" in the eighth line of said section, and inserting in place thereof the words 'twelve hundred,' so that said section so far as it relates to the salary of the county attorney for the county of Hancock, shall read as follows:

Hancock county increased. 'Hancock, twelve hundred dollars.'

Chapter 225.

An Act to Increase the Salary of the County Attorney of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 37; as amended; relating to salaries of county attorneys, further amended. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in line fifteen of said section, after the word "Sagadahoc" the words "seven hundred dollars," and inserting in place thereof the
