by striking out the words "five hundred dollars" in the second line of paragraph five in said section, and inserting in place thereof the words 'seven hundred and eighty dollars,' so that said fifth paragraph of said section, in so far as it relates to the amount allowed for clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds for Franklin county, as amended, shall read as follows:

Allowance for register of deeds, Franklin county, increased. 'Franklin county, for clerks in the office of register of deeds, seven hundred eighty dollars.'

Chapter 255.

An Act Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of the Register of Probate for Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; as amended; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended. 'Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "two hundred" in the second line of paragraph five of said section, and inserting in place thereof the words 'four hundred,' so that said paragraph, as amended, in so far as it relates to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the office of the register of probate for Franklin county, shall read as follows:

Allowance for register of probate, Franklin county, increased. 'For clerks in the office of register of probate, four hundred dollars.'

Chapter 256.

An Act Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Probate for Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; as amended; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended; allowance for register of probate, Knox county, increased. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as amended by chapter forty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, so
