Chapter 263.

An Act Increasing the Allowance for Clerk Hire in the Register of Deeds of Aroostook County, Northern Registry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; as amended; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended. Paragraph three of section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "for clerks in the office of register of deeds of the northern district, one thousand dollars," and inserting in place thereof the words 'for clerks in the office of register of deeds of the northern district, thirteen hundred dollars,' so that said paragraph, so far as it relates to clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds, northern district, of Aroostook county, shall read as follows:

Allowance for register of deeds, northern district, Aroostook county, increased. 'for clerks in the office of register of deeds of the northern district, thirteen hundred dollars.'
