Chapter 26.

An Act to Set Off a Part of the Town of Penobscot in the County of Hancock and Annex the Same to the Town of Castine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Part of Penobscot annexed to Castine. All of that part of the town of Penobscot, in the county of Hancock, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a stone post at the junction of the northerly corner of land of Duncan Dunbar in the town of Castine, and the highway; thence continuing in a general northerly and westerly direction along the right hand boundary of said highway, a distance of approximately four thousand two hundred twenty-four feet, to a stone on the northerly side of the junction of said highway and the Docian shore road so-called; thence southwesterly by the right hand side of said Docian shore road to the town line of Castine at Morse Cove bridge, so-called, a distance of approximately nine hundred and ninety feet; thence running in a southerly and easterly direction along the present dividing line between said Castine and said Penobscot to the point of beginning, is hereby set off from the town of Penobscot and annexed to the town of Castine.

Chapter 27.

An Act to Amend An Act to Incorporate the Richardson Wharf Company Approved April Second, Eighteen Hundred Fifty-six, as Amended by an Act Approved February Thirteenth, Eighteen Hundred Eighty.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1880, c. 205; relating to right of Richardson Wharf Co. to hold property, amended. The act to incorporate the Richardson Wharf Company approved April second, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, as amended by an act approved February thirteen, eighteen hundred and eighty, be, and hereby is amended by striking out the second section of said act as amended, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Limit on amount removed. The said corporation may purchase and hold real and personal estate, with full power to manage and dispose of the same.'
