Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Oakfield for Interest on School Fund.

Oakfield, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be paid to the town of Oakfield forty-four dollars and ninety-seven cents for interest on school fund.

Chapter 14.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Vanceboro to Reimburse It for Money Expended for Support of Otis L. Crocker, State Pauper.

Vanceboro, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be paid to the town of Vanceboro eighty-four dollars to reimburse it for money expended for support of Otis L. Crocker, state pauper.

Chapter 15.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Portage Lake to Reimburse It for Assistance Furnished the Family of Levite Dumond, State Pauper.

Portage Lake, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be paid to the town of Portage Lake to reimburse it for assistance furnished the family of Levite Dumond sixty-five dollars and seventeen cents.
