Chapter 53.

Resolve, in Favor of Cora M. Perkins Providing a State Pension.

Cora M. Perkins, state pension. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to Cora M. Perkins, formerly Cora M. Libby, a pension of ten dollars per month, instead of the amount now received, for the remainder of her life.

Approved March 22, 1927.

Chapter 54.

Resolve, Providing for a State Pension for Mary J. French of Carmel.

Mary J. French, state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mary J. French of Carmel, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 22, 1927.

Chapter 55.

Resolve, Providing for a State Pension for Emily Noddin of Kenduskeag.

Emily Noddin, state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Emily Noddin, of Kenduskeag, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 22, 1927.

Chapter 56.

Resolve, in Favor of Louise D. Mayhew of Mount Vernon in Lieu of Teacher's Pension.

Louise D. Mayhew, teacher's pension. Resolved: That there be allowed and paid out of the appropriation for the payment of teacher's pension, to Louise D. Mayhew of Mount Vernon in the county of Kennebec, the sum of two hundred dollars per annum during the lifetime of the said Louise D. Mayhew, the same to be in lieu of any teacher's pension to which she might be entitled under the law as it now exists, to be paid in equal quarterly payments.
