Chapter 57.

Resolve, to Reimburse Recess Committee for Expenses.

Recess committee on court procedure, payment of expenses of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred fifty-nine dollars and eighty-three cents to be paid to the members of the recess committee on court procedure, named under order of the eighty-second legislature for expenses incurred in performing legislative duties in accordance with the following schedule, the same to be paid from the appropriation for "contingent expenses of committees."

Chapter 58.

Resolve, in Favor of Mrs. Eddie Fitzgerald, Seven Islands, Maine.

Mrs. Eddie Fitzgerald, payment of claim. Resolved: That the sum of fifty dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Mrs. Eddie Fitzgerald, Seven Islands, Aroostook county, on account of amount due on bobcat bounty claims.

Chapter 59.

Resolve, to Appropriate Money to Aid in the Screening of Alford's Lake in the County of Knox.

Knox County Fish and Game Ass'n, installing screens. Resolved: That the sum of sixty-nine dollars and seventy-eight cents be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the Knox County Fish and Game Association of Rockland, to reimburse said association for one-half of the expense of installing a screen at the outlet of Alford's lake in the county of Knox, the same to be paid from the appropriation for inland fish and game.
