## Chapter 103.

Resolve, in Favor of the Pownal State School for Maintenance for the Fiscal Years  
Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-eight and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-nine.

**Pownal State School, for maintenance, etc. Resolved:** That there be,  
and hereby is, appropriated for the Pownal State School:

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages for all officers and employees except for those wholly engaged in repairs of buildings and equipment, for the two years, July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, the sum of eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, the sum of eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars,

For maintenance, namely, for food, supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair, for printing reports of said institution up to date, all materials and supplies incident to the maintenance of the institution and patients thereof, whether present or absent, and all farm feed for the two years, July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, the sum of one hundred thirteen thousand five hundred dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, the sum of one hundred thirteen thousand five hundred dollars,

For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs, additions and upkeep of grounds, buildings and

attached fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of furniture and equipment, including farm equipment and live stock (exclusive of farm feed) and all personal services rendered wholly in connection with repair work for the two years, July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, the sum of forty-nine thousand five hundred and twenty-five dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, the sum of forty-nine thousand five hundred and twenty-five dollars,

Provided that the governor and council may, by order upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriation to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.

## Chapter 104.

Resolve, Providing for the Purchase of "Music and Musicians of Maine."

"Music and Musicians of Maine," to purchase copies of. Resolved: That three hundred copies of "Music and Musicians of Maine" by George Thornton Edwards be purchased by the state at a price not exceeding five dollars per volume and not exceeding the retail price of the book. One copy shall be sent by the librarian of the Maine state library to each public library within the state, and one copy to each of the state normal schools, and the remaining copies shall be distributed at the discretion of the said librarian. The sum of fifteen hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for this purpose.
