Chapter 106.

Resolve, Providing for the Purchase of One Hundred Copies of "Province and Court Records of Maine 1638-1668."

"Province and Court Records of Maine 1638-1668," to purchase copies of. Resolved: That the state librarian be, and hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to purchase one hundred copies of the book entitled "Province and Court Records of Maine, 1638-1668," from the Maine Historical Society, at ten dollars a copy, and that the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated therefor.

Chapter 107.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Kingman for Support of Ed. Priest, a State Pauper.

Kingman, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Kingman, the sum of fifty-three dollars and seventy-four cents, to reimburse said town for money expended for support of Ed. Priest, a state pauper, in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-five.

Chapter 108.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Committee on State Sanatoriums for Expenses,

Walter N. Miner, expenses of committee on state sanatoriums. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid Walter N. Miner, to reimburse the committee on state sanatoriums for expenses incurred in visiting the several sanatoriums of Maine, the sum of one hundred fifty-nine dollars and eighty-eight cents.
