Chapter 113.

Resolve, in Favor of Mrs. Blanche M. Banks of Auburn.

Blanche M. Banks, payment of claim. Resolved: That the sum of three hundred and three dollars be, and the same hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Blanche M. Banks of Auburn for money due her under chapter two hundred seventy-six, public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as the wife of John William Banks, a sailor in the late war.

Chapter 114.

Resolve, in Favor of William H. Hall of Augusta.

William H. Hall, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be paid to William H. Hall of Augusta, the sum of two hundred eighty-five dollars and eighty-five cents for injuries received while working at the Augusta State Hospital, by being struck by an inmate of said institution.

Chapter 115.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Milo for Support of a State Pauper.

Milo, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Milo, the sum of two hundred and eighty-seven dollars and fifty cents, to reimburse said town for money expended for support of Millie Wharton, a state pauper.

Chapter 116.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Unity for Support of a State Pauper.

Unity, town of, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Unity, the sum of six hundred and ninety dollars and eighty-eight cents, to reimburse said town for money expended for support of James W. Dunbar, a state pauper.
