### Chapter 117.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Smyrna for Support of a State Pauper.

**Smyrna, town of, payment of claim.** Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Smyrna, the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars and sixty-four cents, for support of Thomas W. Pluard, a state pauper, in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-five.

### Chapter 118.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Whitefield, for Reimbursement for Sheep Killed  
by Dogs.

**Whitefield, town of, payment of claim.** Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the town of Whitefield, for reimbursement for sheep killed by dogs, the sum of eighty-seven dollars.

### Chapter 119.

Resolve, to Reimburse the City of Bangor for Support of Oscar L. Morrill, a State  
Pauper.

**Bangor, city of, payment of claim.** Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the city of Bangor, the sum of three hundred thirty-four dollars and ninety-five cents, to reimburse said city for money expended for support of Oscar L. Morrill, a state pauper.

### Chapter 120.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Lee for Support of Oliver T. Lyons, a State  
Pauper.

**Lee, town of, payment of claim.** Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Lee, the sum of seventy-eight dollars and sixty cents, to reimburse said town for money expended for support of Oliver T. Lyons, a state pauper.
