CHAP. 136

Chapter 136.

Resolve, in Favor of the Augusta State Hospital.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, at the present time the nurses at the Augusta State Hospital are housed in the same buildings as are the patients, and,

Whereas, as the room for the proper care of the patients and the nurses has become inadequate, and,

Whereas, the crowded conditions render impossible proper treatment of residents and citizens of this state who may be confined therein, and,

Whereas, it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety that the appropriations specified in this resolve be made available for the new construction and equipment of a nurses home in connection with said hospital, which in the mind of the legislature constitutes an emergency within the meaning of the constitution,

Augusta State Hospital, appropriation for nurses' home. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the construction and equipment of a nurse's home for the Augusta State Hospital, the sum of one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars, the same to be expended under the direction of the State Board of Hospital Trustees, subject to the approval of the governor and council. The foregoing amount is to be made available as follows:

- a. \$20,000 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927, which sum is to be taken from the funds in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
 - b. \$115,000 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1928.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

(This Resolve Passed over the Governor's Veto).

Chapter 137.

Resolve, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium for the Maintenance, Personal Services, Repairs and Equipment.

Western Maine Sanatorium, for maintenance, etc. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Western Maine Sanatorium for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, one hundred and thirty-eight thousand five hundred dollars, and for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
