CHAP. 163

Funds to be solicited from cities and towns for newspaper and magazine advertising, names of contributing cities and towns to be mentioned in advertising and included in special service pamphlet of contributing towns.

Maine Development Commission, how composed and appointed. Said funds are to be paid into the state treasury and expended under the direction of a commission known as the Maine Development Commission, which said commission shall be composed of the commissioner of agriculture, commissioner of inland fisheries and game, commissioner of forestry, secretary of state and labor commissioner, with six citizens, representing varied interests of the state of Maine, to be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the council. The first citizen appointees on said commission shall be appointed as follows: two for one year, two for two years and two for three years.

No member of this commission shall receive any compensation for services.

Private contributions may be received from time to time for the purposes herein set forth, and shall be paid into the state treasury and administered in the same manner as funds appropriated by the legislature and those contributed by the cities and towns, or in such manner within the purposes of this act as the donor may provide.

All contracts to be approved by the governor and council.

Chapter 163.

Resolve, in Favor of a Road Leading from Long Pond to Rockwood and from Tarratine to Greenville.

Road, Long Pond to Rockwood etc., appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending in nineteen twenty-eight and twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending in nineteen twenty-nine for construction on highway leading from Long Pond to Rockwood and from Tarratine so-called to Greenville.

Chapter 164.

Resolve, on the Payroll of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-third Legislature.

Payroll of the house of representatives. Resolved: That there be, and

hereby is, appropriated the sum of seventy-four thousand seven hundred and ten dollars, to be paid to the persons named in the following payroll according to the sum set against the name of each.
