Chapter 166.

Resolve, in Favor of the Commissioners of Pharmacy of the State of Maine.

Commissioners of pharmacy, services and expenses. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to be paid to the commissioners of pharmacy, for services rendered and traveling expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

Chapter 167.

Resolve, in Favor of the State School for Boys.

State school for boys, maintenance etc. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, inclusive, the sum of sixty-eight thousand and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees,	\$19,500.00
Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair,	36,000.00
Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,	11,000.00
