CHAP. 168

Repairs to Farrington Cottage,	1,500.00
Interest on trust funds,	42.00

And be it further resolved: that there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, inclusive, the further sum of sixty-eight thousand and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees,	\$19,500.00
Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair,	36,000.00
Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,	11,000.00
Repairs to Farrington Cottage,	1,500.00
Interest on trust funds,	42.00

Provided, that the governor and council, may, by order, upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.

Chapter 168.

Resolve, in Favor of the State School for Girls at Hallowell.

State school for girls, special construction work. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the state school for girls, for reconstructing and furnishing a wing of Erskine Cottage for an infirmary, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars and to aid in the construction of a vegetable cellar in connection with said institution, the sum of five hundred dollars.
