Chapter 175.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Phippsburg for Expenses Incurred in Fighting Forest Fires by the State Militia.

Adjutant General's department, expenses in fighting forest fire. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid the adjutant general's department for expenses incurred in employing the state militia in fighting forest fires in the town of Phippsburg, the sum of nine hundred dollars.

Chapter 176.

Resolve, in Favor of the State Reformatory for Men for the Completion of a Building, Now in Process of Erection.

State reformatory for men, construction of building. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the state reformatory for men for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, for the completion of a building now in process of erection, the sum of forty-three thousand, one hundred fifty-two dollars.

Resolve, to Provide for the Payment of Interest on Kennebec Bridge Bonds during the Period of Construction of Said Bridge and until Tolls and Rentals of said Bridge Shall Become Available Therefor.
