Chapter 196.

Resolve, for the Propagation and Distribution of Pheasants.

Ring-neck pheasants, appropriation for propagation of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the general fund for the maintenance and work of the department of inland fisheries and game the sum of one thousand dollars, or such part thereof as the commissioner of inland fisheries and game may deem for the best interest of the state, after investigation, for the propagation and distribution of ring-neck pheasants in the counties of the state bordering on the sea shore.

Provided interested citizens of the state shall contribute and pay to the state treasurer a like sum for such purpose.

Chapter 197.

Resolve, in Favor of the Pownal State School for Additions and Improvements.

Pownal State School, new construction. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Pownal State School for new construction and improvements for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine the sum of eighty thousand dollars, to be spent by the trustees of the institution under the direction of the governor and council.

Provided further, that the sum herein appropriated shall be expended as follows:

Build one administration building,	80,000.00

Provided that any balance of the sum above appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine which may remain unexpended, shall be available for expenditure during the period July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty.

Chapter 198.

Resolve, in Favor of the State Reformatory for Women for the Erection of a Detention Building.

State reformatory for women, new construction. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the State Reformatory

for Women, at Skowhegan, for the erection of a building to be used for detention purposes of the inmates, the sum of twenty thousand dollars.

Chapter 199.

Resolve, in Favor of the Trustees of the Bridge Between East Machias and Machiasport.

Bridge across Machias river, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for repairing the bridge between East Machias and Machiasport across the Machias river.

Approved April 15, 1927.

Chapter 200.

Resolve, to Pay Certain Deficiencies.

Deficiencies, appropriation for payment of. Resolved: That the sum of twenty-five thousand and twenty-two dollars and sixteen cents be, and hereby is, appropriated to pay such deficiencies as are shown by the lists presented by the state auditor to the legislature, as amended and allowed by the committee on claims.

Chapter 201.

Resolve, in Favor of Henry A. Day, of Bangor, Compensating Him for Loss Sustained in Road Construction upon State Highway.

Henry A. Day, payment of claim. Resolved: That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to pay to Henry A. Day, of Bangor, county of Penobscot, state of Maine, the sum of seventy-five hundred dollars to be paid out of the state highway bond money, said sum being on account of the construction of that part of the state or cement road beginning at a point at or near the dividing line between the town of Veazie and the town of Orono, county of Penobscot, and extending in a northerly direction to a point in the town of Orono, Penobscot county, just beyond the Basin Mills road, so-called.
