#### Chapter 224.

Resolve, in Favor of Murtagh Hughes of Bangor to Reimburse Him for Loss Sustained in Construction of State Highway at Edgecomb.

Murtagh Hughes, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of eight thousand dollars, said sum to be paid out of the state highway bond money, to reimburse Murtagh Hughes of Bangor, Maine, for loss sustained by him in the construction of state highway at Edgecomb.

Approved April 16, 1927.

#### Chapter 225.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for the Purchase of Additional Real Estate for the State School for Girls.

State school for girls, to purchase land. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of eight hundred dollars for the purchase of additional real estate situate in Hallowell, Kennebec county, Maine, needed by the state school for girls, for pasturage.

The same to be expended and said purchase made by the trustees of said institution subject to the approval of the governor and council.

Approved April 16, 1927.

### Chapter 226.

Resolve, in Favor of State School for Girls.

State school for girls, maintenance, etc. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state school for girls for the fiscal year, July first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-eight, inclusive, the sum of eighty thousand, five hundred forty dollars and ninety-six cents for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees,

\$25,000.00

Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair,

42,000.00

Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings, and attached fixtures,

13,000.00
