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CHAP. 243

there be and hereby is appropriated out of the proceeds of bonds issued to provide funds for the building of bridges, the sum of ten thousand five hundred dollars to be expended in the construction of an international bridge over the St. Croix river between the village of Forest City, township of Forest City, Washington county, Maine, and the village of Forest City, parish of North Lake, York county, New Brunswick: Provided that this appropriation shall not be expended nor shall its expenditure be contemplated until or unless the Dominion of Canada or the Province of New Brunswick shall provide and authorize the expenditure of a sum of money adequate to pay one-half the cost of the substructure and superstructure of the bridge proper and of the highway approaches thereof: Provided further that the expenditure of this appropriation and the planning and construction of the bridge in so far as the state of Maine shall be concerned shall be under the direction and supervision of the state highway commission.

Chapter 243.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Starks for a Bridge.

Bridge at Starks, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-eight, same being the proportionate part of the expense for the town of Starks for a bridge across Hilton brook, so called, in said town, if said bridge is constructed under the bridge act, so called.

Chapter 244.

Resolve, in Favor of Lower Village Bridge in the Town of Phillips, Franklin County.

Phillips, town of, construction of bridge. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of six thousand dollars to aid the town of Phillips in the reconstruction of lower village bridge over Sandy river.

Chapter 245.

Resolve, in Favor of Stanley Bridge in the Town of Hampden, Penobscot County.

Hampden, town of, construction of bridge. Resolved: That there be,

and hereby is, appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars, to aid the town of Hampden in the reconstruction of Stanley bridge over Soudabcook stream on the highway leading from West Hampden to Hermon Center.

Chapter 246.

Resolve, to Aid the Town of Hope in the Construction of a Bridge.

Hope, town of, construction of bridge. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars to aid the town of Hope in the county of Knox, in paying its part of the cost of construction of a bridge known as the Handley bridge on the state aid road leading from Hope to Camden. Said appropriation is to be expended under the direction of the state highway commission.

Chapter 247.

Resolve, in Favor of Several Academies, Institutes, Seminaries and Colleges for Maintenance, Repairs and Improvements.

Academies, institutes, etc., in aid of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the several academies, institutes, seminaries and colleges hereinafter listed the sum of seventy-one thousand, nine hundred dollars for the period from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-eight, and the sum of seventy-two thousand, nine hundred dollars for the period from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-nine, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said institutions to the amount and for the purposes indicated in the following schedule:

For the period from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-eight.

Anson Academy, for maintenance, repairs and improvements	\$3,500.00
Aroostook Central Institute, for maintenance	1,000.00
Berwick Academy, for maintenance and repairs	1,500.00
Blue Hill-George Stevens Academy, for maintenance	1,200.00
Bridgewater Classical Institute, for maintenance	800.00
Bridgton Academy, for maintenance	3,750.00
Cherryfield Academy, for maintenance and repairs	1,000.00
