Chapter 256.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of West Gardiner.

West Gardiner, town of, road in. Resolved: That there be paid to the town of West Gardiner the sum of one thousand dollars for maintenance and repairs on the Litchfield road, known as the Litchfield Neck road, for the fiscal year of nineteen hundred twenty-seven and nineteen hundred twenty-eight, the same to be paid from any money not otherwise appropriated.

Chapter 257.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Skowhegan.

Skowhegan, town of, construction of bridge. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars to aid the town of Skowhegan in the construction of a bridge across the Kennebec river, at some point below the existing railroad bridge.

This bridge shall be constructed under the provisions of the bridge act, so called, and construction work shall be started in the year nineteen hundred twenty-seven.

(Passed over Governor's veto, April 16.)
