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further amended. Paragraph nine of section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in the second line thereof the word "six" and inserting in place thereof the word 'eight' so the said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

Clerk hire in Lincoln county offices increased. 'Lincoln County; for clerks in the office of register of deeds eight hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate one hundred sixty dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, two hundred dollars.'

Chapter 10.

An Act Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of the Register of Probate in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; as amended; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended; Androscoggin county increased. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in paragraph two of said section, line two, after the words "register of probate" the words "five hundred twenty dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'twelve hundred dollars,' so that said line in so far as it relates to clerk hire in the office of register of probate, as amended, shall read as follows: 'for clerks in the office of register of probate, twelve hundred dollars.'

Chapter 11.

An Act to Provide for the Support of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Mill tax provided for support of University of Maine. A tax of one mill on a dollar shall annually be assessed upon all the property in the state according to the valuation thereof and shall be known as the mill tax for the support of the University of Maine.

Sec. 2. Assessment and collection of tax. This tax shall be assessed and collected in the same manner as other state taxes and be paid into the state treasury and designated as the University of Maine fund.

Sec. 3. How fund shall be disbursed; is in lieu of all other state sup-

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port except trust funds. This fund shall be disbursed by the state treasurer upon proper order of the trustees of the University of Maine upon requisition approved by the governor and council. This fund shall be in lieu of all other state support, except trust funds held by the state for the benefit of the university and from said fund the trustees shall provide for the necessary buildings, equipment and maintenance of all departments of the university. From said fund shall also be paid such moneys as may be necessary to meet federal requirements in connection with said university.

Chapter 12.

An Act Relating to the Salary of the Register of Probate of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 39; as amended; relating to compensation of registers of probate. Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended, by striking out all of line eighteen of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'Somerset, eighteen hundred dollars,' so that said line shall read as follows:

Somerset county, increased. 'Somerset, eighteen hundred dollars.'

Approved March 1, 1929.

Chapter 13.

An Act to Fix the Salary of the Judge of Probate for the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 38; as amended; relating to compensation of judges of probate. Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out all of line seventeen of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'Somerset, fifteen hundred dollars,' so that said line as amended shall read as follows:

Somerset county, increased. 'Somerset, fifteen hundred dollars.'

Chapter 14.

An Act to Amend the Banking Laws of This State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
