Sec. 27. Act to make uniform law. This act shall be so interpreted and construed as to effectuate its general purpose to make uniform the law of those states which enact it.

Sec. 28. Invalidity of any part not to affect remaining portions. If any part of this act is for any reason declared void, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this act.

Sec. 29. Inconsistent acts repealed. All acts or parts of acts and administrative rules inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 30. How cited. This act may be cited as the uniform criminal extradition act.

Chapter 125.

An Act to Increase the Salary of the Treasurer of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 44; relating to salaries of county treasurers, further amended. Section forty-four of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended, by striking out in line five of said section after the word "Androscoggin" the words "eighteen hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words "two thousand," so that said line as amended, shall read as follows:

Androscoggin county increased. 'Androscoggin, two thousand dollars.'

Chapter 126.

An Act Relating to Amount Allowed for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Register of Deeds in Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in the first and second lines of the twelfth paragraph thereof the words "seven hundred and twenty-eight" and inserting in place thereof the words "eight hundred and eighty-four," so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

Piscataquis county clerk hire increased. 'Piscataquis county; for clerks in the office of register of deeds, eight hundred and eighty-four dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate, two hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, five hundred dollars.'
