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COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, HANCOCK COUNTY.

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'twenty-five hundred dollars' so that said line, as amended, shall read as follows:

Aroostook county increased. 'Aroostook, twenty-five hundred dollars.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; as amended; relating to clerk hire in county offices, further amended. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended, by striking out in line four of paragraph three of said section the words "one thousand dollars" and inserting in place thereof, the words 'fifteen hundred and sixty dollars,' so that said paragraph of said section, so far as it relates to the amount allowed for clerk hire in the office of the register of probate in Aroostook county, as amended, shall read as follows:

Aroostook county register of probate clerk hire increased. 'for clerks in the office of the register of probate, fifteen hundred and sixty dollars.'

Chapter 249.

An Act Relating to the Salary of the County Commissioners in Oxford County. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 42; as amended; relating to compensation of county commissioners, further amended. Section forty-two of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in the thirteenth line thereof after the word "Oxford" the word "six" and inserting in place thereof the word 'seven,' so that said line, as amended, shall read as follows:

Oxford county increased. 'Oxford, seven hundred dollars.'

Chapter 250.

An Act Relating to the Regular Sessions of County Commissioners of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 83, sec. 5; as amended; relating to regular sessions of county commissioners of Hancock county, further amended. Section five of chapter eighty-three of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "Hancock, on the second Tuesdays of January and October and fourth Tuesday of April," in the tenth and eleventh lines of said section and substituting therefor the words, 'Hancock, on the second Tuesdays of April, September and December,' so that said tenth and eleventh lines, as amended, shall read as follows:
