Supplementary to Private and Special Acts of the Regular Session

Chapter 132.

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Eleven of the Private and Special Laws of 1925, Being An Act to Incorporate Dexter P. Cooper, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1925, c. 111, relating to incorporation of Dexter P. Cooper, Inc., amended. Chapter one hundred eleven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sections:

'Sec. 11. Empowered to develop and utilize tidal powers located wholly within boundaries of United States. Said corporation is empowered to develop and utilize the power of the tides at or near Eastport and Lubec by dams and structures located wholly within the territorial boundaries of the United States of America and in such event it shall not be necessary for said corporation to secure any allocation of power between the United States and the Dominion of Canada as required in section seven; provided, however, that said corporation shall not erect any dams or structures within the territorial limits of the Dominion of Canada without previously securing such allocation.

'Sec. 12. Charter of corporation affirmed in other respects. In all other respects and subject to all other conditions therein contained the charter of said corporation is hereby affirmed.'
