Chapter 16.

Resolve, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Mrs. Alfred Polk of
Lewiston.

Mrs. Alfred Polk, state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mrs. Alfred Polk, of Lewiston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

Approved March 1, 1929.

Chapter 17.

Resolve, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Frank A. Choate of
Montville.

Frank A. Choate, increase in state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Frank A. Choate, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which he is now receiving.

Approved March 1, 1929.

Chapter 18.

Resolve, in Favor of Abbie A. Norton, of Industry, for State Pension.

Abbie A. Norton, state pension. Resolved: That there be paid to Abbie A. Norton, of Industry the sum of thirty dollars per month, payable monthly from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions, beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continuing during the remainder of her life; such state pension shall be in lieu of payment under chapter eighty-seven of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and payment under said chapter shall be discontinued.

Chapter 19.

Resolve, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Ivanilla Nute, of
Lewiston.

Ivanilla Nuté, pension repealed. Resolved: That chapter one hundred
