is, appropriated, the sum of ten thousand dollars for the construction and equipment of a building in which may be segregated the inmates of the state prison who are afflicted with contagious diseases.

Chapter 68.

Resolve, in Favor of the Pownal State School.

Pownal state school, new construction. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Pownal state school, for new construction and improvements for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, the sum of two hundred and ten thousand dollars, said amount to be dependent on the surplus revenue of the state for new construction, to be spent by the trustees of the institution under direction of the governor and council.

Provided further, that the sum herein appropriated shall be expended as follows:

Build and equip one hospital building,	\$210,000.00
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Provided that any balance of the sum appropriated above for the year nineteen hundred and thirty, which may remain unexpended shall be available for expenditure during the period July first, nineteen hundred and thirty to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-one.

Chapter 69.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Lyman.

Lyman, town of, for road construction. Resolved: That the sum of three thousand fifty-four dollars and twenty-five cents, which was set apart and appropriated by the state as its portion of the amount required for the construction of a state aid highway in the town of Lyman, and is now in the state treasury, be, and the same is hereby appropriated to the town of Lyman to aid in the repair of the road leading from Waterboro to South Hollis in Hollis.

Approved March 28, 1929.

Chapter 70.

Resolve, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium for the Construction of a Superintendent's Home.

Western Maine Sanatorium, construction of superintendent's home.

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Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for the Western Maine Sanatorium the sum of nine thousand dollars for the construction and equipment of a superintendent's home, said sum to be available from surplus revenue funds.

Approved March 28, 1929.

Chapter 71.

Resolve, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for Construction and Equipment of an Additional Building for Patients.

Central Maine Sanatorium, for additional building. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Central Maine Sanatorium, the sum of forty thousand dollars for the construction and equipment of an additional building for patients, said sum to be available from surplus revenue funds.

Chapter 72.

Resolve, in Favor of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians for the General Care, Maintenance and Education Thereof.

Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians, for care, maintenance, etc. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the state treasury to be expended under the direction of the governor and council, by the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, for the benefit of said tribe for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, and for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and thirty to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, as follows:
