**Chapter 82.**

Resolve, Providing for a State Pension for Anna L. Gagan of Lewiston.

**Anna L. Gagan, state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Anna L. Gagan, of Lewiston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

**Chapter 83.**

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Medway.

**Medway, town of, appropriation for replanking bridge. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars to aid in replanking the bridge over the East Branch of the Penobscot river in the town of Medway, provided the town of Medway raises five hundred dollars for the same purpose, the funds for this bridge to be taken from the maintenance fund.

**Chapter 84.**

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Dover-Foxcroft.

**Dover-Foxcroft, town of, for reconstruction of bridge. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is appropriated, from the bridge loan fund, the sum of seventeen thousand four hundred dollars to be used as the town of Dover-Foxcroft's share of the cost of reconstruction of Dover bridge, under the "Bridge Act."

**Chapter 85.**

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Kingman.

**Kingman, town of, for repairing of bridge. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is appropriated from funds available for maintenance of bridges the sum of four thousand dollars to be used in repairing the

bridge over the Mattawamkeag river in the town of Kingman, the work to be done under the supervision of the state highway commission.

Approved April 2, 1929.

### Chapter 86.

Resolve, in Favor of the Bangor State Hospital for Additional Equipment and Renovations.

**Bangor State Hospital, for additional equipment, etc. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Bangor State Hospital for the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, the sum of twenty-nine thousand dollars. Of said sum there shall be applied to the remodelling of kitchen, three thousand dollars, renovation of the cold storage plant, six thousand dollars, additional laundry equipment, eight thousand dollars, an elevator in building D, seven thousand dollars, and a new piggery, five thousand dollars.

### Chapter 87.

Resolve, in Favor of the State School for Boys.

**State School for Boys, for maintenance, etc. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, inclusive, the sum of sixty-eight thousand, three hundred and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees,	\$20,300.00
Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair,	36,000.00
Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,	12,000.00
Interest on trust funds,	42.00

And be it further resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nineteen hundred and thirty, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, the further sum of sixty-eight thousand, three hundred and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:
