lars to aid in repairing the road from Caribou town line to Perham, known as the South Road beginning where the completed portion of the third class road ends.

**Town of Woodstock** the sum of one thousand dollars to aid in repairing the road extending from Woodstock toward Rumford.

1,000

**Town of Woolwich** the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for construction and repair of the highway in the town of Woolwich known as the River Road, leading from Sagadahoc Ferry to Augusta, between the intersection with the state aid road known as the Middle road and the Dresden town line.

**Town of Yarmouth** the sum of one thousand dollars to be expended on the road from Princes Point Road to Drinkwaters Point.

**Town of York** the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars to aid in grading and resurfacing the old town Post Road from the residence of Dwight Bodwell to the junction with the new state highway leading from Portland to Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

## MISCELLANEOUS

**Town of Gouldsboro** the sum of six thousand dollars to aid in repairing the road from Prospect Harbor to Corea, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for the fiscal year nineteen hundred thirty and three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for the fiscal year nineteen hundred thirty-one. Said funds to come from the Road Reconstruction Fund.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency recited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.

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**Chapter 149.**

Resolve, to Provide for the Completion of the Raised Road Between Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle.

**Raised road across the bar between Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle, appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is appropriated, the sum of five thousand dollars to complete the construction of a raised road across the bar between the islands of Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle in the county of Hancock, as authorized by chapter one hundred and

twelve of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven; said sum to be expended under the direction of the state highway department. This resolve is on condition that the town raise five thousand dollars to be expended on the said raised road in the same year as the state's appropriation. Said funds are to be taken from the highway construction fund.

### Chapter 150.

Resolve, in Favor of Screening Whetstone Pond, or Sylvan Lake.

**Screening of Whetstone pond or Sylvan lake, appropriation for; conditions. Resolved:** That the sum of two hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated, the same to be taken from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended under the directions of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game for screening Whetstone pond or Sylvan lake, in the town of Abbot in the county of Piscataquis, provided that a similar amount is otherwise contributed for the same purpose.

### Chapter 151.

Resolve, in Favor of an Appropriation for the Promotion of the Welfare and Hygiene of Maternity and Childhood.

**Promotion of the welfare and hygiene of maternity and childhood, appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and thirty and twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, for the promotion of the welfare and hygiene of maternity and childhood, the same to be expended under the direction of the state department of health.

### Chapter 152.

Resolve, in Favor of the Townships of Township One, Range Nine, Township Two Range Nine, and Township Three, Range Nine.

**Sourdnahunk and Togue pond roads, appropriation for repair and maintenance. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and thirty and twenty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, to aid in the repair and maintenance of the Sour-
