**Chapter 155.**

Resolve, Appropriating Money to Screen the Outlet of Syladobsis Lake, Commonly Called Lower Dobsis Lake, in Township Five, North Division, in the County of Washington.

**Screening the outlet of Syladobsis lake, appropriation for; conditions.**  
**Resolved:** That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game to aid in screening Syladobsis lake, provided, however, that no appropriation hereafter specified for the erection of a screen at the outlet of said lake shall be available until some responsible corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet of said lake to be screened is situated, shall have in legal town meeting and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same, and, provided further, that said appropriation shall not be available until the citizens of the county in which said lake to be screened is situated, shall have paid into the state treasury the balance necessary as found by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game to erect said screen, and, provided further, if the actual cost of said screen in this resolve be less than the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall be liable for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any appropriation hereinafter named, or part thereof, not expended during the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine shall be available during the year nineteen hundred and thirty.

**State School for Girls, for maintenance, etc. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the state school for girls for the fiscal year, July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nine-
