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### Chapter 164.

Resolve, in Favor of Henry Soucie, of Township Number Fourteen, Range Six, Aroostook County, Maine.

**Henry Soucie, payment of claim. Resolved:** That the sum of sixty-four dollars be and is hereby appropriated to reimburse Henry Soucie for damage done his oat crop by deer in the season of nineteen hundred twenty-three.
