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### Chapter 168.

Resolve, to Provide for a Memorial to Harold T. Andrews, the First Maine Man to Lose His Life in the World War.

**Memorial to Harold T. Andrews, appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated during the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, the sum of two thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting in the state house some suitable memorial to the late Harold T. Andrews, of Portland, the first Maine man to lose his life in the American Expeditionary Forces in the World War. The governor is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a commission of three persons to serve without pay to make all necessary contracts and arrangements for the erection of the memorial. All the necessary expenses of the commission appointed under the provisions of this resolve incident to the carrying out of the provisions of this resolve shall be paid from the sum hereby appropriated.

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### Chapter 169.

Resolve, on the Payroll of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-fourth Legislature.

**Payroll of the house of representatives. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred five thousand, sixty-one dollars, to be paid to the persons named in the following payroll according to the sum set against the name of each.
