courts for that county; said commissioner shall, immediately upon the adoption of any such rules and regulations contemplated by this section, file an attested copy of the same in the office of the secretary of state.

Chapter 234.

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 29, sec. 54; relating to registration fees for motor vehicles, amended. Section fifty-four of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the third line of the last paragraph of said section the word "October" and substituting in place thereof the word 'September', so that the last paragraph of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'**Sec. 54.** Registration from September on for one-half regular fee. On any application for registration applied for by an owner resident of this state, of a motor vehicle or trailer, not including a log hauler, or traction engine, during the period between the first day of September and the thirty-first day of December, one-half the registration fee shall be charged. The secretary of state upon granting the application shall register in a book or upon suitable index cards to be kept for the purpose, the vehicle described in the application, giving to its owner a distinguishing number or other mark, and shall thereupon issue a certificate of registration which shall contain the name, place of residence and address of the owner.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 29, sec. 60; relating to registration of dealers, amended. Section sixty of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth line from the end of said section the word "October" and substituting in place thereof the word 'September', so that the last two sentences of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'**Sec. 60.** Registration by dealers after September first for one-half regular fee. On application for registration, or for additional plates applied for by said manufacturers or dealers during the period between the first day of September and the thirty-first day of December in any year, one-half of the registration fee shall be charged. No motor truck, tractor, or trailer registered under this section shall be used for other than demonstration or emergency purposes.'
