Chapter 281.

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Sheriff of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, sec. 42; relative to the salary of the sheriff of Somerset county, amended. Section forty-two of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the sixteenth line thereof, the words "fourteen hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words 'sixteen hundred,' so that said line, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Somerset, sixteen hundred dollars.'
