Chapter 1.

AN ACT to Authorize the Treasurer of the County of Penobscot to Purchase a Set of Maine Reports.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine reports for Penobscot county. The treasurer of the county of Penobscot is hereby authorized and directed, subject to the approval of the Penobscot County Law Library Association, to purchase one set of Maine Reports, for the use of the Penobscot County Law Library Association, for a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.

Chapter 2.

AN ACT to Change the Name of The Congregational Conference and Missionary Society of Maine and to Enlarge Its Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. Change of name. The name of The Congregational Conference and Missionary Society of Maine, incorporated by chapter five hundred twenty-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred seventy-
