exceeding the sum of one hundred thousand dollars" in the third and fourth lines and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'and as shall be approved by the public utilities commission', so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 12. May issue bonds and mortgage property. Said company may issue its bonds for the construction of its works of any and all kinds, upon such rates and time and to such amount or amounts as it may deem expedient, and as shall be approved by the public utilities commission and secure the same by mortgage of the franchise and property of said company.'

Chapter 46.

AN ACT Extending Charter of the "Madawaska Water Company."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1929, c. 93; relating to charter of Madawaska Water Company; extended. The powers and privileges granted to the Madawaska Water Company by chapter ninety-three of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-nine, hereby are extended for a further period of two years.

Chapter 47.

AN ACT to Extend the Rights, Powers and Privileges of the Sabattus
Water and Sewer District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1929, c. 48; relating to Sabattus Water and Sewer District; charter extended. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sabattus Water and Sewer District, which were granted by chapter forty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-nine, are hereby revived and extended for and during a period of two years from the date when this act shall take effect; and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act to said Sabattus Water and Sewer District may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as provided in said act.
